#### Épisode 1

Mot ou expression / Word or Expression	Explication / Explanation
Clairière	<i>Clearing.</i> An open space in a forest where sunlight can reach the ground.
Belette	<i>Weasel.</i> A small carnivorous mammal with a long body, similar to a ferret.
« Être aux aguets »	<i>To be on the lookout / to be watchful.</i> This expression means to stay alert and carefully watch for danger or something important.
Tuteur	<i>Guardian.</i> A person responsible for caring for someone who cannot fully care for themselves, such as a child.
Tentation	<i>Temptation.</i> Something that strongly attracts or encourages someone to do something, even if it could have bad consequences later.
Tumulte	<i>Inner turmoil / agitation.</i> A strong feeling of emotional agitation or confusion inside oneself.
Bardeaux	<i>Wooden shingles.</i> Small wooden panels used to cover the outside walls or roofs of buildings.
Volets	<i>Shutters.</i> Solid wooden or metal panels that cover and protect windows.
Coquelicot	<i>Poppy.</i> A bright red wildflower. In Canada, the poppy is also used as a symbol to honour military veterans
Écume	<i>Foam / sea foam.</i> White foam that forms on the surface of moving or rough water.
Cime	<i>Treetop / summit.</i> The very top or highest part of something, especially a tree.

<b>Cèdre</b>	<i>Cedar.</i> A type of conifer tree often used as a hedge around houses.
<b>Thé des bois</b>	<i>Wintergreen.</i> A small forest plant with a fresh mint-like smell and taste.
<b>Mets</b>	<i>Dish / prepared food.</i> A prepared food served during a meal.
<b>« Avoir l'estomac dans les talons »</b>	<i>To be starving.</i> A French expression meaning to be extremely hungry.
<b>Soie</b>	<i>Silk.</i> A very soft fibre produced by caterpillars to make their cocoons.
<b>Robuste</b>	<i>Strong / sturdy.</i> Solid, strong, and resistant.
<b>Fantasque</b>	<i>Whimsical / unpredictable.</i> Someone whose mood or behaviour changes often.
<b>Dévouée</b>	<i>Devoted.</i> Someone who puts a lot of effort and care into helping a person or cause.
<b>Bannie</b>	<i>Banished.</i> Permanently removed, rejected, or excluded.

## Épisode 2

<b>Mot ou expression / Word or Expression</b>	<b>Explication / Explanation</b>
<b>Banale</b>	<i>Ordinary / commonplace.</i> Something very common or unoriginal that does not seem special or interesting.
<b>Hypnotisé</b>	<i>Hypnotized.</i> In a hypnotized state, a person seems deeply fascinated or controlled, almost like being in a waking dream.
<b>Écorché</b>	<i>Scraped / grazed.</i> A minor skin injury caused by scratching or rubbing the skin.
<b>« Compresse de chou »</b>	<i>Cabbage compress / cabbage leaf remedy.</i> A traditional remedy where cabbage leaves are placed on the body to reduce pain or swelling.

## Épisode 3

<b>Mot ou expression / Word or Expression</b>	<b>Explication / Explanation</b>
<b>« Le blé mûr des cheveux »</b>	<i>Hair like ripe wheat.</i> A poetic image comparing golden blond hair to ripe golden wheat fields.
<b>Épier</b>	<i>To spy on / to watch secretly.</i> To observe someone secretly without being seen.

<b>Ravin</b>	<i>Ravine.</i> A deep, narrow valley with steep sides.
<b>Légende</b>	<i>Legend.</i> A fictional story inspired by real events and transformed over time.
<b>Lieu clos</b>	<i>Enclosed place.</i> A closed or confined place.
<b>« La course d'une lune »</b>	<i>A lunar cycle.</i> The time it takes for the moon to complete all of its phases, about 28 days.
<b>Terrassé</b>	<i>Overwhelmed / devastated.</i> A state in which someone is unable to react because of a very strong emotion or shock.
<b>« La force de l'âge »</b>	<i>The prime of life.</i> The age when a person is at their strongest and healthiest.

## Épisode 4

<b>Mot ou expression / Word or Expression</b>	<b>Explication / Explanation</b>
<b>« Coup de sang »</b>	<i>Sudden burst of anger / rush of emotion.</i> A sudden surge of strong emotion or adrenaline that puts the body in a heightened state of alertness.
<b>Plénitude</b>	<i>Contentment / deep contentment.</i> A feeling of complete happiness, peace, and well-being.
<b>« De la crête aux ergots »</b>	<i>From head to toe (for a rooster).</i> An expression meaning completely or entirely, specifically using parts of a rooster's body.
<b>Lueur</b>	<i>Glow / faint light.</i> The first soft light of the morning.
<b>« L'heure du chien qui finit et celle du loup qui commence »</b>	<i>The time between day and night.</i> A poetic expression describing twilight, when daylight disappears and night begins.
<b>Meute</b>	<i>Pack.</i> A group of canines such as wolves or dogs travelling together.
<b>Coche</b>	<i>Notch / mark.</i> A carved mark used for counting or keeping track of something.
